



THESE TICKET TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAIN A BINDING ARBITRATION PROVISION AND CLASS ACTION WAIVER AND OTHERWISE AFFECT THE HOLDER'S LEGAL RIGHTS. BY ACCEPTING THESE TERMS BEFORE AN EVENT, OR TENDERING THIS TICKET AND ENTERING THE VENUE, THE HOLDER IS DEEMED TO HAVE READ THESE TERMS, AND AGREES TO BE BOUND BY THEM.

Applicability of Terms and Conditions

This ticket is a revocable license that grants Holder a one-time admission into Lumen Field Event Center (collectively, "Venue") and the Seattle RV Show. **The person seeking admission pursuant to such license and any accompanying minors (collectively, "Holder") agrees that such license is subject to and governed by these terms and conditions ("Terms").** Failure to comply with any of these Terms shall result in forfeiture of this license and waiver of all rights arising hereunder without refund and shall entitle Operator to pursue all available remedies. "Operator" means MHRV Show Association, Inc. and First & Goal Inc. collectively. Operator may, in its sole discretion, refuse or revoke admission or eject Holder.

Refunds, Exchanges, and Remedies

ALL TICKET SALES ARE FINAL. NO REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THESE TERMS. The sole and exclusive remedy if admission is refused or revoked, Venue capacity limitations result in ticket cancellation, or if the Event is cancelled for any reason and not rescheduled, is a refund of up to the face value of the ticket set by Operator or the promoter. Operator's liability for breach of these Terms shall not exceed the Face Value. **IN NO EVENT SHALL OPERATOR BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING ANY AMOUNT PAID IN EXCESS OF THE FACE VALUE FOR THIS TICKET.** The date and time of the Event (and the opening of the gates) are subject to change by Operator and/or the promoter in its sole discretion. No such change shall entitle Holder to a refund or any other remedy if Holder cannot attend the Event or for any other reason.

Compliance With Applicable Policies

Holder must comply with Operator's policies, including security policies, codes of conduct, health and safety policies and assessments, and bag policies. Holder and his/her belongings may be searched and/or assessed prior to and/or upon entry into the Venue and/or other security checkpoints. Prohibited items may be confiscated and/or Holder may be denied admission or have admission revoked at any time at the sole discretion of Operator. Holder consents to all such searches and assessments and waives all claims related to them. If Holder refuses to submit

to any such search or assessment, Holder acknowledges that Operator has the right to deny admission or to eject Holder from the Event without a refund. **OPERATOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DENY ADMISSION TO OR EJECT ANY PERSON WHO, IN OPERATOR'S SOLE DISCRETION, VIOLATES THESE TERMS OR ANY APPLICABLE CODE OF CONDUCT, POSES A RISK TO THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF OTHER ATTENDEES, OR IS OTHERWISE DISORDERLY, IN EACH CASE, WITHOUT REFUND.**

Transmission of Data and Right of Publicity

Holder agrees not to create, transmit, display, distribute, exploit, misappropriate, or sell (or aid in such activity) (1) in any form, any description or account (whether text, data, or visual, and including play-by-play data) of the Event or related events (collectively, "Descriptive Data") for any commercial or non-personal purpose; (2) any photograph, image, video, audio, content, or other form of display or public performance or reproduction of any portion of the Event or related events ("Works") for any commercial or non-personal purpose; or (3) livestreams of any portion of the Event or related events ("Livestreams"). Notwithstanding the foregoing, Holder grants Operator an exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual, sub-licensable, royalty-free license to all rights associated with the Works, the Livestreams, and, to the extent permitted by law, the Descriptive Data. Holder also grants irrevocable permission to Operator, and their respective sponsors, licensees, advertisers, broadcasters, designees, partners, and agents to capture, use, publish, distribute, edit, modify, and/or alter Holder's image, likeness, voice, actions, and statements in any medium, including any marketing materials, audio, video, film, photographs, social media, exhibition, transmission, publication, or reproduction of the Event, for any purpose without further authorization or compensation, and Holder waives all claims and potential claims relating to such use unless, and only to the extent, prohibited by law.

Arbitration and Class Action Waiver

ANY DISPUTE, CLAIM, OR CAUSE OF ACTION IN ANY WAY RELATED TO THIS TICKET OR THE EVENT SHALL BE RESOLVED BY MANDATORY, CONFIDENTIAL, FINAL, AND BINDING ARBITRATION IN A MUTUALLY AGREED UPON LOCATION. HOLDER AND OPERATOR AGREE THAT ALL DISPUTES SHALL BE ARBITRATED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS AND WAIVE ANY RIGHT TO LITIGATE OR ARBITRATE ANY CLAIM AS A CLASS ACTION, REPRESENTATIVE ACTION, OR CLASS ARBITRATION. IF HOLDER DOES NOT CONSENT TO THIS CLAUSE, HOLDER MUST LEAVE OR NOT ENTER THE VENUE. THIS CLAUSE, INCLUDING ITS INTERPRETATION AND ENFORCEMENT, IS GOVERNED BY THE FEDERAL ARBITRATION ACT.

Assumption of Risk

HOLDER VOLUNTARILY ASSUMES ALL RISKS, HAZARDS, AND DANGERS incident to the Event and related events, including the risk of personal injury and death, exposure to communicable diseases, viruses, bacteria, or illnesses or the causes thereof, or lost, stolen, or damaged property, whether occurring before, during, or after the Event, however caused, and

hereby waives all claims and potential claims relating to such risks, hazards, and dangers. **THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS SARS-COV-2 (TOGETHER WITH ANY VARIATION THEREOF, "COVID-19") IS AN EXTREMELY CONTAGIOUS DISEASE THAT CAN LEAD TO SEVERE ILLNESS AND DEATH. THE CDC ADVISES THAT SENIOR CITIZENS AND THOSE WITH UNDERLYING MEDICAL CONDITIONS ARE ESPECIALLY VULNERABLE. Further, this ticket may not be used for, or in connection with, any form of commercial or trade purposes, including advertising, promotions, contests, sweepstakes, giveaways, gambling, or gaming activities, without the express written consent of Operator. Use of this ticket in violation of any law is strictly prohibited and will result in seizure, revocation, and/or forfeiture of this license without refund.

Fan Health Promise and Ticket Pod Integrity

Holder agrees, on behalf of Holder and anyone for whom Holder obtains a ticket, that Holder and each such individual will not attend the Event if they have tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days prior to the Event, or, unless they are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (as defined by the CDC), any of the following is true on the Event date:

- within the prior 14 days, they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or are subject to a federal or local travel or quarantine advisory due to COVID-19;
- within the prior 48 hours, they have experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., fever of 100.4°F or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain/achiness, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nasal congestion, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue or any other symptoms identified by the CDC) (anyone who is fully vaccinated but experiences any of the above symptoms within 48 hours before the Event should nevertheless consult a healthcare provider and get tested for COVID-19 before attending).

Release, Waiver, and Covenant Not to Sue

On behalf of Holder and Holder's Related Persons (defined below), Holder releases (and covenants not to sue) each of the Released Parties (defined below) with respect to any and all claims that Holder or any of Holder's Related Persons may have (or hereafter accrue), against any of the Released Parties, that relate to any of the risks, hazards and dangers described above, including without limitation any and all claims that arise out of or relate in any way to (1) Holder's exposure to COVID-19; (2) Holder's entry into, or presence within or around, the Event (including all risks related thereto, and including without limitation in parking areas or entry gates) or compliance with any protocols applicable to the Event; or (3) any interaction between

Holder and any personnel of any of the Released Parties present at the Event, in each case whether caused by any action, inaction, or negligence of any Released Party or otherwise.

As used herein:

- "Related Persons" means Holder's heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, next of kin, anyone attending the Event with Holder (which persons Holder represents have authorized Holder to act on their behalf for purposes of the release herein), and other persons acting or purporting to act on Holder's or their behalf.
- "Released Parties" means: MHRV Show Association, Inc., First & Goal Inc., First & Goal Hospitality, Inc., Levy Premium Foodservice Limited Partnership, the Washington State Public Stadium Authority (PSA), NFL Ventures, Inc., NFL Ventures, L.P., the National Football League and its other professional member clubs, and each of their respective direct and indirect affiliates, administrators, designees, licensees, agents, owners, officers, directors, employees, contractors (and all employees of such contractors) and other personnel; (ii) all third parties performing services at the Venue; and (iii) any parents, subsidiaries, affiliated and related companies and officers, directors, owners, members, managers, partners, employers, employees, agents, contractors, sub-contractors, insurers, representatives, successors and/or assigns of each of the foregoing entities and persons, whether past, present, or future and whether in their institutional or personal capacities.

Other Terms

These Terms are intended to be interpreted to the broadest extent permitted by law. If any part of these Terms is held to be unenforceable, then that part is to be construed by modifying it to the minimum extent necessary to make it enforceable, and the rest of the Terms shall remain in full force and effect as written. "Including" means "including, without limitation." In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between these Terms and any other terms and conditions related to the Holder's use of this ticket, these Terms shall supersede and govern to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. The Operator may make changes to these Terms at any time. Any changes will be effective immediately when a revised version of these Terms is posted. By accepting these Terms or tendering this ticket after that date, you agree to all changes.
